Confirmation is a practice or "rite" in which a person publicly admits (or "professes") his/her faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior. It is a confirmation of the faith that God has created in us. We invite all young Christians who have been baptized into the Christian faith to be a part of our program starting in the 7th grade. Students can join later than the 7th grade year and start the two year process at the grade that they are in as well.

Notes for Acolytes

- 1). Each student will need to sign up to acolyte 7 times between September 2023 August 2024 (Including 8th-grade students The Rite of Confirmation does not mean the end of acolyting. Please fulfill your acolyte duty even if it extends after the Rite of Confirmation in April.) There are 440 acolyte spots throughout the year and more will open up on Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Lenten services.
- 2). Services include Sunday 7:45AM, 9:00AM, 10:30AM, Wednesday 7:00pm, and Saturday 5:00pm.
- Special services such as Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Lent will be sent out at a later time.
- 3). We allow parents to choose what weeks work for them. With this privilege, we expect students to show up each time they are scheduled and to fulfill their requirements.

Acolyte Updates for 2023-2024

- 1). Acolytes have new robes this year! No sash/ rope is needed with their robe.
- 2). Acolytes will be sitting up with Pastors/ Vicar during services.
- 3). Acolytes may be asked to help out with various things in the service throughout the year.
- 4). Please arrive 15 minutes prior to each service, so that you can get robed, grab a sermon sentence, and meet with Elder who will be helping you.
