## STEWARDSHIP

### 7th Sunday after Pentecost Jeremiah 17:9-13

There is always a lot of discussion around how God rewards the giver. Because the Bible has so many passages that tell us that it happens, we can ignore the other side of the story. The promises of God are true for those who manage their resources well and with God's purposes in mind. But our reading for today tells us that mismanagement of resources, getting rich by unjust means or by shameless deception are not tolerated and will not be rewarded - rather they will be punished. We are not saved by our deeds, but God may choose to reward (or punish) us because of the way we handle His creation and the resources He gives to us. Doing things God's way can make life easier for everyone around and rewarding for the doer. Be a manager of all of your resources for God's purposes and let God give whatever reward He chooses through His grace.
