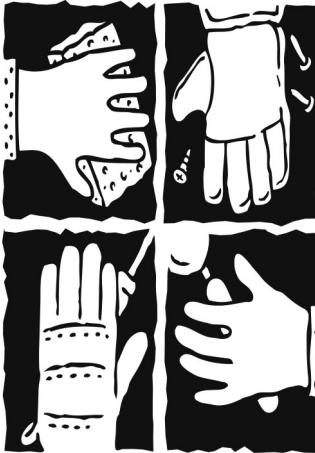
Jr. High Game Night– Join us for pizza & games in the gym on Wednesday, Oct. 19th, from 7:45-8:30 pm after the WOW service.

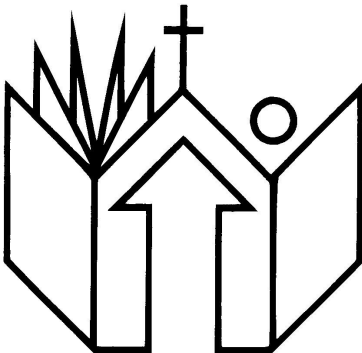

Ways to walk

If you think walking is boring or repetitive, read 52 Ways to Walk. Author Annabel Streets shares dozens of variations on this healthy pastime. From walking in the cold or at altitude to walking along a river or barefoot (or even backward!), each technique offers different benefits and new perspectives. Other ideas include a sensory walk, a silent walk, a foraging walk and singing while strolling.

As Christians know, walking can be a great time to connect with God in prayer too.

Scripture speaks often about our spiritual walk: We are to walk "faithfully" with God (Genesis 5:24, NIV), walk "in all his ways" (Joshua 22:5, NRSV), walk "humbly" with God (Micah 6:8), walk "while you have the light" (John 12:35), walk while praising God (Acts 3:8), walk "by faith, not by sight" (2 Corinthians 5:7), walk "by the Spirit" (Galatians 5:16) and walk "in the same way" as Jesus walked (1 John 2:6, NRSV). As we walk — even through dark valleys — we're never alone. God promises, "I will walk among you and be your God" (Leviticus 26:12, NIV).

16th Sunday after Pentecost 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Paul knew how serious his sins were. He had persecuted the followers of the way before Jesus met him on the road to Damascus and turned his life around. He realized that on his own merit he didn't deserve to be called an apostle, but only by God's grace, which empowered him to bring the news of Jesus' life, death and resurrection to both Jews and Gentiles. By God's grace we also can be strengthened to put our sins behind us and work for His kingdom. His grace is deeper and higher and wider than our sin. We can never repay the debt for our sin, but Christ paid it for us. By grace we can serve Him by leading others to know Him, by using our blessings in His service, providing aid to the homeless, feeding the hungry, comforting those who are hurting, demonstrating the love of Christ to all who see us.
