8:05-11:15

TIME	ACTIVITY	WE ARE LEARNING...
8:05-8:20	Arrival/ Morning Activities	Students choose an activity. They are learning various literacy, math, science, art and/or fine motor concepts/skills.
8:20-8:45	Morning Meeting	We review the calendar, pray, greet our friends. Many different math skills are embedded into calendar time.
8:45-9:20	Learning Centers	Students will work on various learning centers aligning with our themes for the week. We work on math, literacy, fine motor, creativity skills.
9:20-9:40	Bathrooms/ Snack	Snack provides many opportunities to explore math concepts and social skills. Students practice proper handwashing and self help skills in the bathroom.
9:40-10:00	Gym time/ Recess	Various gross motor skills will be worked on daily. Students will learn to work together and play with others.
10:00-10:25	Jesus Time	While Jesus is a part of our whole school day, we’ll spend some time each day learning about His life and that of God’s word.
10:25-10:30	Songs/ movement time	Music time is filled with songs, rhymes, instruments and use of gross motor. Throughout music we build and learn various language skills, phonemic awareness, math concepts, social skills and gross motor skills.

10:30-10:55	Free Choice Time	Students will use problem solving skills, creativity, self help, and many more skills during this time.
10:55-11:00	Clean up	We learn new bible stories each week. We learn about God and Jesus' love for us and how we can be more like Him.
11:100-11:05	Closing Circle	Every day we will close our day with a final song and end of the day talk. This gives students time to reflect on their day.
11:05-11:15	Packup/ Dismissal	We will work on independence, self help skills while packing up their backpack and getting coats on.
